1. WHY THIS PRIVACY POLICY?

RENTUS - Portus bv attaches great importance to the protection of your privacy and personal data. We will only use your personal data in accordance with the Privacy Act and other relevant current statutory regulations. Any reference in this Privacy Statement to the Privacy Act is a reference to the Act of 8 December 1992 on the protection of privacy in relation to the processing of personal data. Any reference to the Regulation is a reference to the Regulation of 27 April 2016 on the protection of natural persons with regard to the processing of personal data and on the free movement of such data.

With this Privacy Statement, RENTUS - Portus bv would like to draw your attention to any processing operations regarding this data and to your rights. By using our platform/our website/our application, you explicitly give your consent with possible processing operations by RENTUS - Portus bv.

It is possible that this Privacy Statement will be subject to updates and changes in the future. It is up to you to consult this document on a regular basis. Any substantial changes will always be clearly communicated on the platform of RENTUS - Portus bv.

3. WHAT PERSONAL DATA ARE PROCESSED?

RENTUS - Portus bv undertakes to process only those data that are relevant and necessary for the purposes for which they were collected. The following categories of personal data may be processed by RENTUS - Portus bv:

- Personal identification information (last name, first name, address)
- Contact information (phone number, email address)

4. FOR WHAT PURPOSES ARE MY PERSONAL DATA USED?

RENTUS - Portus bv collects personal data in order to provide you with a safe, optimal and personalized user experience. The collection of personal data becomes more extensive as you intensively use the platform/website/application and our online services. Data processing is essential for the operation of the platform/website/application and its services. The processing is done only for the following specified purposes:

- Providing and improving a general and personalized service; including billing purposes, offering information, newsletters and offers that are useful and/or necessary for you, obtaining and processing user reviews and providing support.
- Marketing purposes

When visiting the platform/website/application of RENTUS - Portus bv, some data is collected for statistical purposes. Such data are necessary to optimize the use of our platform/website/application. These data are: IP address, presumed place of consultation, hour and day of consultation, which pages were visited. When you visit the platform/website/application of RENTUS - Portus bv you agree

to this data collection intended for static purposes as described above.

The User shall always provide the personal data to RENTUS - Portus bv himself and in this way can exercise a certain control. If certain data is incomplete or apparently incorrect, RENTUS - Portus bv reserves the right to postpone certain expected actions temporarily or permanently.

Personal data will only be processed for internal use within RENTUS - Portus bv.

We can therefore reassure you that personal data will not be sold, passed on or communicated to third parties connected to us. RENTUS - Portus bv has taken all possible legal and technical precautions to avoid unauthorized access and use.

5. WE USE COOKIES TOO!

During a visit to our platform/website, 'cookies' may be placed on your hard drive to better tailor the platform/website to the needs of the returning visitor. Non-functional cookies help us to optimize your visit to the platform and to remember technical choices.

For a further understanding of how we use cookies to collect and process your personal data, please refer to our Cookie Statement.

If you want to consult the platform/website of RENTUS - Portus bv, it is recommended that you have cookies enabled. How you can disable cookies, on the other hand, can also be read in our Cookie Statement.

6. WHAT ARE MY RIGHTS?

6.1 Guaranteeing lawful and secure processing of personal data

RENTUS - Portus bv always processes your personal data fairly and lawfully. This includes the following guarantees:

- Personal data is processed only in accordance with the defined and legitimate purposes of this Privacy Statement.
- Personal data is only processed to the extent that it is adequate, relevant and not excessive.
- Personal data will be retained only as long as necessary to fulfill the defined and legitimate purposes in this Privacy Statement.

The necessary technical and security measures have been taken to reduce to a minimum the risks of unlawful access to or processing of the personal data. In case of a break-in in its computer systems, RENTUS - Portus bv will immediately take all possible measures to minimize the damage.

6.2 Right to access/correct/delete your personal data

Upon proof of your identity as a User, you have a right to obtain a decision from RENTUS - Portus bv as to whether or not your personal data is being processed. If RENTUS-Portus bv processes your data, you also have the right to peruse the personal data collected. If you wish to exercise your right of inspection, RENTUS-Portus bv will comply with this within one (1) month after receipt of the request. The request is made by registered mail or by sending an e-mail to info@rentus.be.

Inaccurate or incomplete personal data can always be corrected. It is up to the User to correct inaccuracies and incompleteness in the first place. You may exercise your right to correction by providing RENTUS - Portus bv with an additional statement, which RENTUS - Portus bv will comply with within one (1) month after receiving the additional statement.

You also have the right to have your personal data deleted by us without unreasonable delay. You can only invoke this right to be forgotten in the following cases:

- When the personal data is no longer needed for the purposes for which it was originally collected;
- When the personal data was collected on the basis of obtained consent and no other legal basis exists for the processing;
- Where an objection is made to the processing and there are no overriding compelling legitimate grounds for the processing;
- When the personal data was unlawfully processed;
- When the personal data must be deleted in accordance with a legal obligation.

RENTUS - Portus bv assesses the presence of any of the aforementioned cases.

6.3 Right to restrict/object to the processing of your personal data
User has the right to obtain a restriction on the processing of your personal data:

- During the period necessary for RENTUS - Portus bv to verify the accuracy of the personal data, in case of dispute;
- When the data processing is unlawful and User requests the restriction of the processing instead of the erasure of the personal data;
- When RENTUS - Portus bv no longer needs the personal data of the User for the processing purposes and User needs the personal data regarding a legal claim;

- During the period necessary for RENTUS - Portus bv to assess the presence of the grounds for deletion of personal data.

Furthermore, User has the right to object at any time to the processing of his/her personal data. RENTUS - Portus bv shall then cease the processing of your personal data, unless RENTUS - Portus bv can provide compelling legitimate grounds for the processing of your personal data that outweigh the User's right to object.

If User wishes to exercise these rights, RENTUS - Portus bv will comply with this within one (1) month after receiving the request. The request is made by registered mail or by e-mail to info@rentus.be.

6.4 Right to data portability

User has the right to obtain the personal data provided to RENTUS - Portus bv in a structured, common and machine-readable form. In addition, User has the right to transfer this personal data to another data controller if the processing of the personal data rests solely on User's obtained consent.

If User wishes to exercise this right, RENTUS - Portus bv will comply with it within one (1) month after receiving the request. The request is made by registered mail or by email to info@rentus.be.

6.5 Right to withdraw my consent/right to lodge complaint

User has the right to withdraw its consent at any time. The withdrawal of consent shall not affect the lawfulness of the processing on the basis of the consent before its withdrawal. In addition, User has the right to lodge a complaint regarding the processing of his personal data by RENTUS - Portus bv with the Belgian Commission for the Protection of Privacy.

If the User wishes to exercise this right, RENTUS - Portus bv shall do so within one (1) month after receiving the request. The

Cookie Policy

1. COOKIES

Cookies are small data or text files placed on your local computer by websites and applications. Such cookies can have different purposes: there are technical cookies (for example, to keep track of language settings), session cookies (temporary cookies that expire after one session) and tracking cookies (cookies that follow and track your behavior on the Internet, so that we can offer you a more optimal user experience).

The Belgian Electronic Communications Act of 13 June 2005 contains a number of provisions relating to cookies and their use on websites. The law is a transposition of the European e-Privacy Directive, which means that the cookie legislation can be implemented differently in other European member states.

RENTUS - Portus bv is located in Belgium and therefore follows the Belgian legislation regarding cookies.

2. PURPOSE AND USEFULNESS OF COOKIES

RENTUS - Portus bv would like to inform each visitor of the platform/website as well as possible about their rights under Belgian legislation regarding cookies, and about which cookies RENTUS - Portus bv uses. By using the platform/website, the visitor agrees to the use of cookies. Cookies help RENTUS - Portus bv to optimize your visit to the platform/website, to remember technical choices (e.g. choice of language, newsletter, etc.) and to show you more relevant services and offers.

If you want to consult the platform/website of RENTUS - Portus bv, it is recommended that the technical settings for cookies are enabled. Without cookies enabled, RENTUS - Portus bv cannot guarantee a trouble-free visit to the platform/website. If you prefer not to have the cookies, you are free as a visitor to disable them.

We use cookies to improve your visit to our platform/website. The cookies we use are safe. The information we collect using cookies helps us to identify any errors or to show you specific services that we think may be of interest to you.

3. TYPE OF COOKIES USED BY RENTUS - PORTUS BV

We distinguish the following types of cookies, according to their purposes:

- **Essential/ Strictly necessary cookies:**
These cookies are necessary for the platform/website to function and cannot be disabled in our systems. They are usually only set in response to actions set by you, such as setting your privacy preferences, logging in or filling out forms. They are necessary for proper communication and they facilitate navigation (e.g. returning to a previous page, etc.).
- **Non-essential cookies:**
These cookies are not in themselves necessary for the platform/website to function, but they help us to offer an improved and personalized website.
 - **Functional Cookies:** These cookies allow the platform/website to provide enhanced functionality and personalization. They can be set by us or by third-party providers whose services we have added to our pages.
 - **Analytical cookies:** These cookies allow us to track visits and traffic so we can measure and improve the performance of our platform/website. They help us know which pages are most and least popular and how visitors move through the platform/website.
 - **Targeting / advertising cookies:** These cookies may be set by our advertising partners through our

platform/website. They may be used by those companies to build a profile of your interests and show you relevant ads on other sites.

We use our own cookies on the one hand and cookies from carefully selected partners with whom we work and who advertise our services on their websites on the other.

4. MANAGEMENT OF COOKIES

Make sure cookies are enabled in your browser. To enable cookies, the following actions must be performed:

By browser - Microsoft Internet Explorer

- In Internet Explorer, click on 'Internet Options' from the 'Tools' menu.
- On the 'Privacy' tab, move the settings slider to 'low' or 'accept all cookies' (setting above 'medium' disables cookies).
- Click on 'OK'.

By browser - Mozilla Firefox

- Click on 'Firefox' in the top left corner of your browser and then click on 'Options'.
- On the 'Privacy' tab, make sure the 'Let websites know I don't want to be tracked' is unchecked.
- Click on 'OK'.

By browser - Google Chrome

- Click on the three dots next to the browser bar at the top of your browser window and choose 'Options'.
- Find the 'Privacy and security' section and click on 'content settings'.
- Click on the 'cookies' option.
- Now select 'Allow sites to save and read cookie data'.

By browser - Safari

- Choose 'Preferences' from the task menu. (The task menu is located in the upper right corner of the Safari window and looks like a cog or click on 'Safari' in the expanded task menu.)

- Click on the Privacy tab. Find the section called 'Cookies and other website data'.
- Indicate that you accept cookies.

If you want to consult the platform/website of RENTUS - Portus bv, it is recommended that you have cookies enabled. However, if you prefer not to, as a visitor you are free to disable cookies through your browser settings. This can be done in the following ways:

By browser - Microsoft Internet Explorer

- In Internet Explorer, select the Tools button and select Internet Options.
- Select the Privacy tab and under Settings, move the slider up to block all cookies.
- Click OK.

By browser - Mozilla Firefox

- Click on the menu button and choose 'Preferences'.
- Select the 'Privacy & Security' panel and go to the 'History' section.
- Next to 'Firefox will', set 'Use custom settings for history'
- Set 'Accept third-party cookies' to 'Never'.
- Close the 'about: preferences' page. Changes you have made will be saved automatically.

By browser - Google Chrome

- Select 'More Settings' from the browser toolbar.
- At the bottom of the page, select the 'Advanced' option.
- Under 'Privacy and security', select 'Content settings'.
- Select 'Cookies'.
- Uncheck 'Allow sites to store and read cookie data'.

By browser - Safari

- Choose 'Preferences' from the task menu. (The task menu is located in the upper right corner of the Safari window and

looks like a cog or click on 'Safari' in the expanded task menu.)

- Click on the Privacy tab. Find the section called 'Cookies and other website data'.
- Indicate that you do not accept cookies.

Or consult the help function of your internet browser for this.

5. RIGHTS OF VISITORS

As cookies may constitute processing of personal data, you as a data subject have the right to the lawful and secure processing of personal data. As a data subject, you can exercise the following rights:

- Right to object: If there are compelling and legitimate grounds, one may object to the processing of personal data.
- Right of access: Any data subject proving his identity has a right to access the information concerning the existence or absence of processing operations on his personal data, as well as the purposes of such processing, the categories of data concerned by such processing and the categories of recipients to whom the data are disclosed.
- Right to rectification: Inaccurate or incomplete personal data may always be rectified or even deleted at the request of the data subject.

The exercise of these rights is done in accordance with the modalities as stipulated in our Privacy Statement.
